## **Telephone System**

We are pleased to announce that we have upgraded our telephone system, which now includes a call-back option. This feature has been working well so far and has proven to be a valuable addition. With the call-back option, the system will call you back when you are number 1 in the queue, reducing wait times and helping you avoid the frustration of being on hold. We believe this improvement will enhance your overall experience when contacting us, making it easier and more efficient for you to get the assistance you need. # **Pharmacy First**

Community pharmacists are now able supply prescription-only medicines, including antibiotics and antivirals where clinically appropriate, to treat seven common health conditions without the need to visit a GP.

- Sinusitis
- Sore throat
- Earache
- · Infected insect bite
- Impetigo (a bacterial skin infection)
- Shingles
- Uncomplicated urinary tract infections in women

You can get treatment for these conditions by walking into the pharmacy or contacting them virtually. GP receptionists, NHS 111 and providers of emergency care will also be able to direct patients to pharmacies that offer the service, if contacted.

Patients can still choose to visit a GP if they wish to. Pharmacy First offers alternative access for these seven conditions and we encourage people to make the most of this service and to consult the highly trained professions in their local pharmacy.

## **Contraceptive Services**

Contraceptive Coils (IUS or IUD systems). A contraception counselling session with Dr Eastbrook is required to discuss suitability before booking a coil insertion appointment.

Coil removals are available at the practice, this can be booked with Dr Eastbrook or with Petrina, our Practice Nurse.

Dr Camm is now providing the Contraceptive Implant at Balmoral Surgery. An appointment prior to the administration of the implant will need to be booked with Dr Camm to discuss suitability.

## **Patient Forum Group**

Balmoral Surgery has a patient forum which always welcomes new members. The Forum usually meets three times a year and aims to give our patients the opportunity to have their say about the services the surgery provides and to keep members upto-date with new developments etc. The minutes of the forum meetings are available on our website and if you are interested in joining, please contact us.
